INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP

Qualifying points for the Championships Grand Finals will be awarded to the placed horses in each Heat as follows:—

First Horse, 4 points Second Horse, 2 points Third Horse, 1 point

The twelve horses which gain the greatest aggregate of points, shall be eligible to start in the Grand Finals, subject however, to the Championships Programme Committee having power to increase the number of starters above the number of 12 and to select the additional starters. Where two or more horses gain the same number of points, the Championships Programme Committee shall decide which will start in the Grand Finals.

MAXIMUM HANDICAP MARKS:

The maximum handicap marks will be as under:—

1 $\frac{3}{8}$ miles	36 yards behind
1 $\frac{5}{8}$ miles	48 yards behind
2 miles	48 yards behind

FIXED HANDICAPS:

Once a horse is handicapped for the Championships no penalty will be incurred in the Grand Finals as a result of any placed performances in a Qualifying Race (or Heat).

GRAND FINAL AND CONSOLATION RACES:

The Championships Programme Committee shall be the sole judge of which horses are entitled to start in either the Championship Grand Finals or Consolation Races. To be eligible to start in the Grand Final horses must start in the three Qualifying Heats unless special permission is given by the Championships Programme Committee to withdraw a horse from a Heat.

DOUBLES INVESTORS

Investors failing to change their winning tickets on the First Race of the Double before the Double Totalisator closes for the Second Race of the Double have no further interest in or claim upon any amount invested and are not entitled to any refund.

BY LAW OF CLUB

The collecting of totalisator tickets in the Stands and grounds of the Auckland Trotting Club is prohibited, and any person found doing so will be removed from the Course.

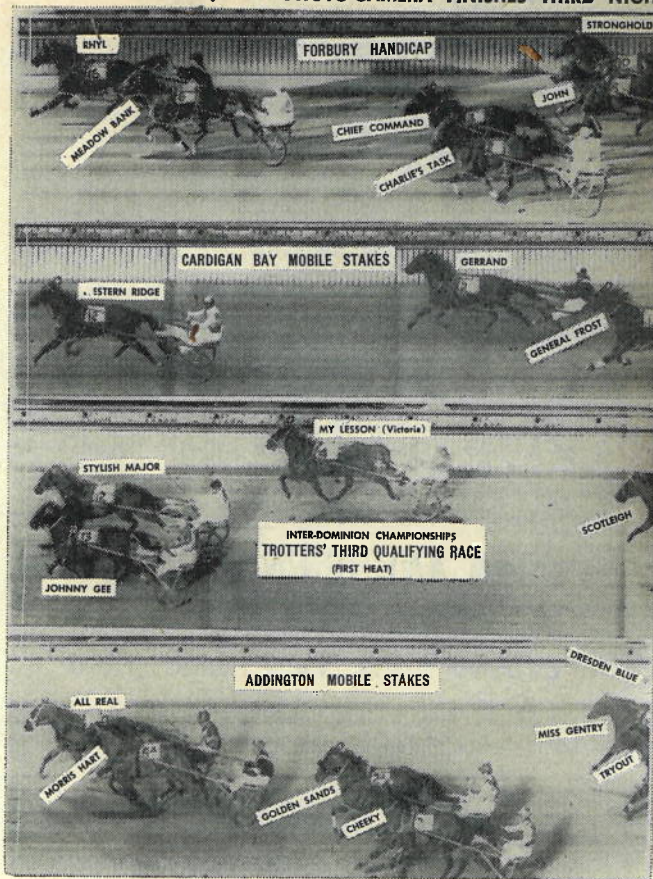

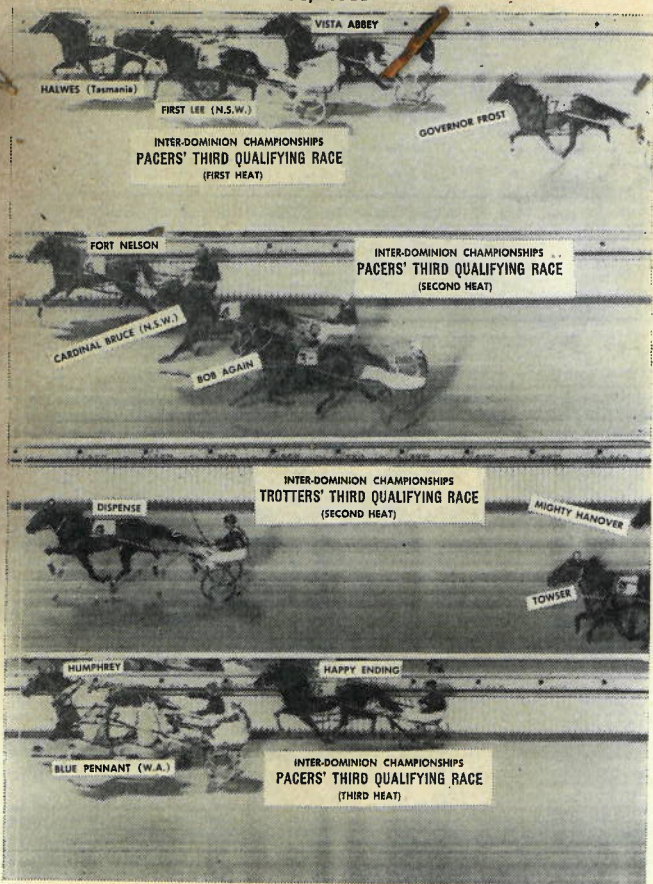
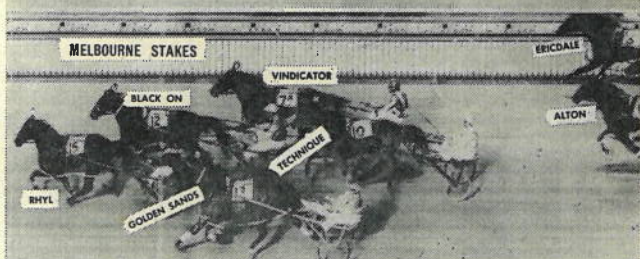


PHOTO-CAMERA FINISHES SECOND NIGHT

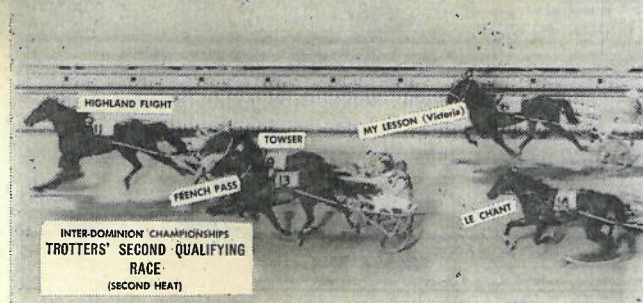
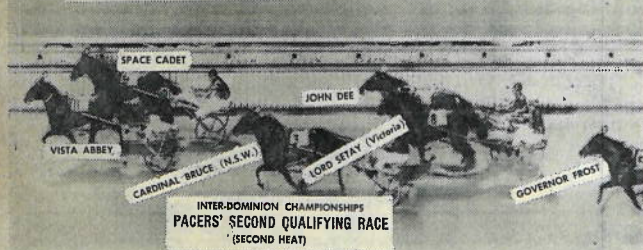
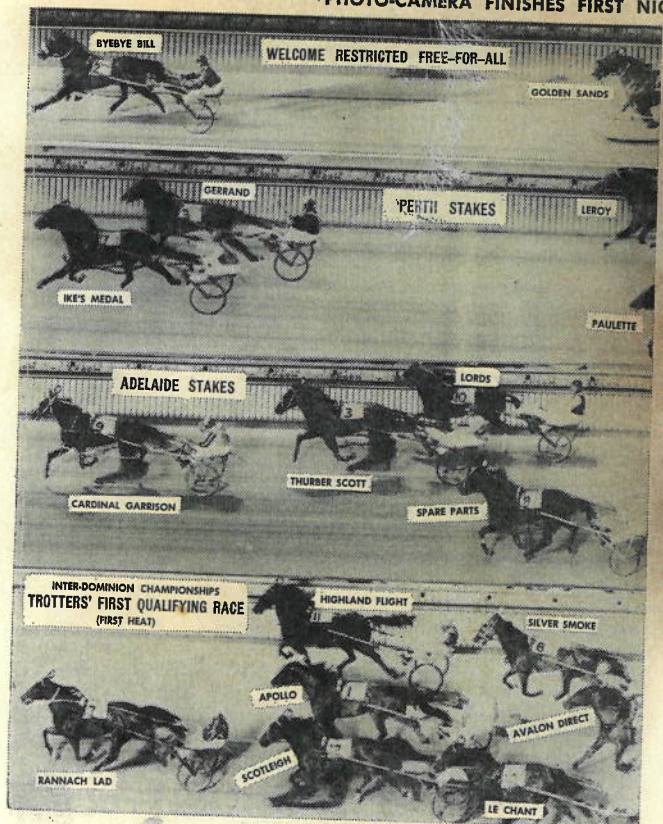
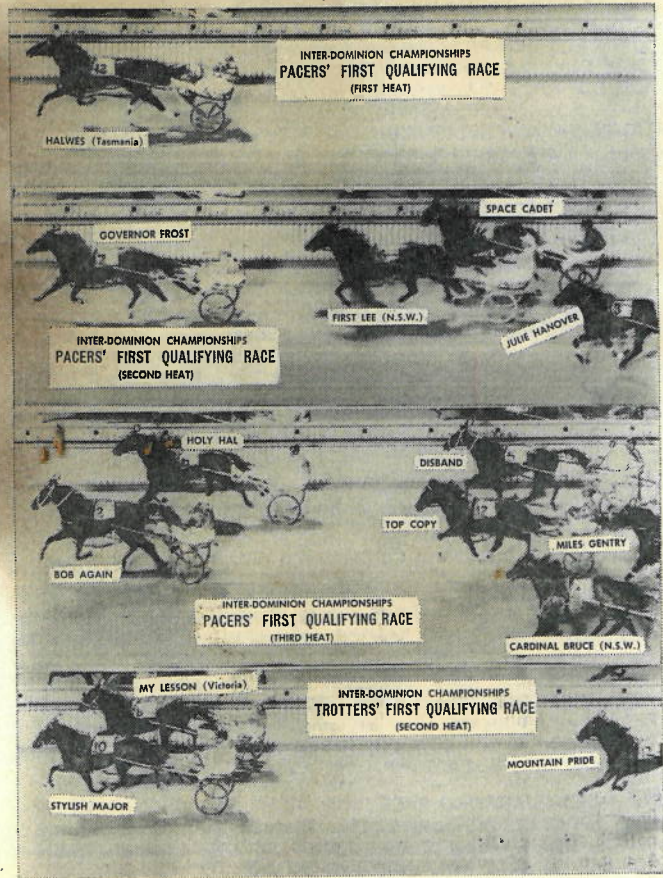


PHOTO-CAMERA FINISHES FIRST NIGHT

ELECTRIC INDICATORS—WIN AND PLACE

Automatically calculated dividends for Win and Place betting will be shown on the Electric Indicators. Dividends are shown in two lines, with the Win Dividend appearing on the top line, and the Place Dividend on the bottom line.

Automatic Win and Place Lampboxes have been designed by the manufacturer to display dividends between \$1 and \$99 but the mechanism can show only one of 35 different dividends for any horse.

These 35 positions are as follows:—

Should the dividend be between these positions the lesser figure is shown.

For dividends between \$1 and \$4.50 a red strip will separate the dollars from the cents and numbers to the right of this red decimal strip will represent units of 10 cents e.g. 4.5 = \$4.50.

AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB

REGULATIONS UNDER "THE GAMING ACT 1908"

"IN pursuance and exercise of the powers under section 33 of the Gaming Act 1908, it is hereby resolved that the regulations dated the 27th day of August 1923 are hereby revoked, and in lieu thereof the following regulations shall be regulations under the said section 33 controlling the admission of persons to that part of the Auckland Trotting Club's Course situated in the District of One Tree Hill and known as the Alexandra Park Raceway, or to any other racecourse used or occupied by the club for race meetings."

1. These regulations shall come into force on the date of the same being published in the "Gazette".

2. In these regulations the words "bookmaker", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by section 2 of the Gaming Act, 1908.

3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from the race course above described or any other racecourse while the same is used or occupied by the said club for a race meeting, namely:

- (a) Bookmakers.
- (b) Bookmakers' clerks, bookmakers' assistants, and bookmakers' agents.
- (c) All persons under disqualification imposed under the New Zealand rules of racing or the New Zealand rules of trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand which have reciprocal agreements in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference.
- (d) Common prostitutes, idle and disorderly persons within the meaning of the Police Offences Act, 1927.
- (e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house breaking, burglary, or pocket picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act, 1908, and persons convicted under the Police Offences Act, 1927, of conversion or attempted conversion of a motorcar or other vehicle or of being idle and disorderly persons or of being a rogue and vagabond and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act, 1908 or persons having a criminal record in countries outside New Zealand, and the references to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution therefor.

Provided always that the Executive Committee appointed by the New Zealand Trotting Conference, upon being satisfied by evidence as to the character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of this regulation should have relief from the effect thereof, may grant exemption to any such person, and may at any time revoke any such exemption without notice to such person, and without assigning any reason for such revocation.

DOUBLES TOTALISATOR CONDITIONS

Patrons are requested to make themselves familiar with the Doubles Totalisator Regulations and any special information which for their convenience are displayed on the Stands and Totalisator buildings.

Every investor shall select a starter to win the First Leg.

The holder of any ticket on the first horse as defined in the Regulations in the First Leg may change such tickets as follows: \$2 tickets, for \$2, \$1 or 50c tickets, each of which may be invested on any starter in the Second Leg. \$1 tickets, either (a) For a ticket of the same value on any starter in the Second Leg, or (b) For 50c tickets each of which may be invested on any starter in the Second Leg at the Doubles windows.

If any ticket is purchased on a horse which does not weigh out for, or which is for any reason withdrawn from the First Leg BEFORE the Doubles Totalisator is closed for that race, the holder of a ticket on any such horse shall be entitled at his option to a ticket on any other starter, or to a refund, provided that no ticket shall be exchanged at any time after the Doubles Totalisator closes for the First Leg.

If any ticket is purchased on a horse which does not weigh out for or which for any reason is withdrawn from the First Leg after the Doubles Totalisator is closed for that race and before the Starter declares a start the investment may be refunded on the Steward's decision. This does not apply to any horse which forms part of a bracket with any horse or horses and which start.

If a horse accepted as a starter for the Second Leg is for any reason withdrawn from that race at any time AFTER the running of the First Leg and BEFORE the Starter has declared a start for the Second Leg subject to the ticket holder's right to change tickets BEFORE the Doubles Totalisator close all the ON-COURSE investments remaining on the withdrawn horse at the time the Doubles Totalisator closes shall be dealt with as follows:

If the withdrawn horse is bracketed then the investments will remain on the other horse or horses in the bracket; if the withdrawn horse is not bracketed the investments will be transferred to the ON COURSE favourite as determined by the Stewards in accordance with regulations under the Rules of Racing and by reference to investments made ON COURSE only. Until the Doubles Totalisator closes for the Second Leg a holder of a ticket on a withdrawn horse (whether bracketed or not) has the right to change his ticket for a ticket on a starter.

If a ticket is not changed the investment is not forfeited but will be transferred to the ON COURSE favourite as set out above.

In accordance with the Rules of Totalisator Agency Board OFF-COURSE investments will be transferred to the Off-Course favourite.

Patrons are especially warned against destroying their tickets on the Double until the dividend has been declared.

RACEWAY AMENITIES

Totalisators, cafeterias and bars are shown on the plan opposite.

As well as the Main Totalisator Houses on the lawn, there are windows in the ground floor and first floor of the Main Public Stand, at the front of the Outside Enclosure Stand and near the Horsebox Area. (Please note that patrons are NOT allowed to enter the Horsebox Area.)

Licensed bars are the Garden Bar and Green Lane Bar, near "A" Totalisator House; mixed bars at the Western end of both Public Stands; and the Cardigan Bar Inn, for women or women and escorts, on the first floor of the Public Stand.

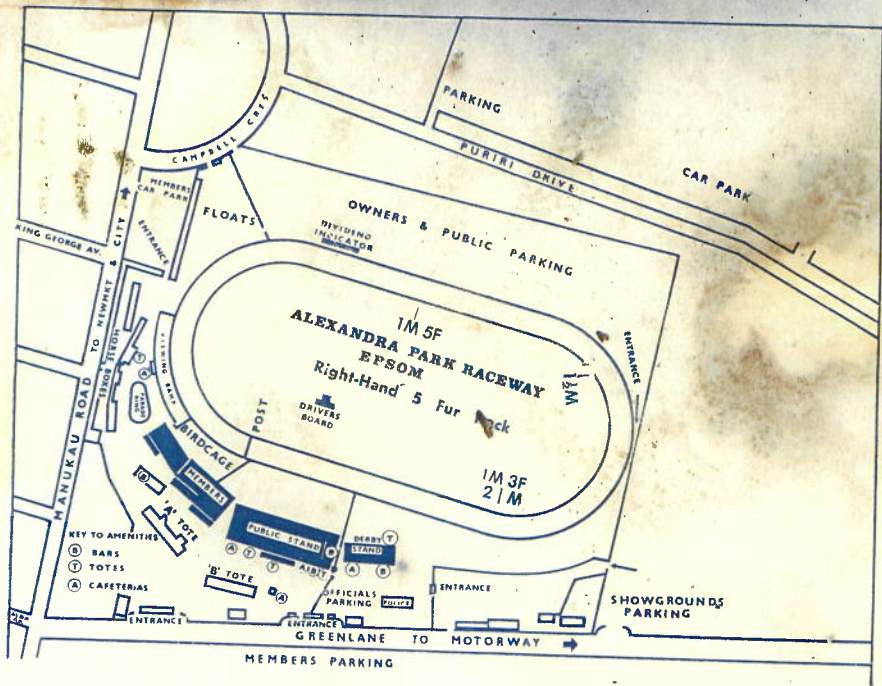
