TROTTING CONTROL BOARD

Doubles and Quinella

- 1. A Doubles totalisator will operate on "this and the next" for the 1st. 2nd. 3rd. 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th Races. A Quinella totalisator will operate on all races.
- 2. In selecting a Double the investor must ask for the racebook number of the horse required in the 1st leg First and then the racebook number of the horse required in the 2nd leg.
- 3. An investor may invest in a Double as many times as desired.

For example, if he wishes to Couple Nos. 3 and 7 more than once he should say "Nos. 3 and 7, two tickets", or whatever number of times he requires the double.

. FIELD BETTING -

Certain windows will be available for Doubles and Quinella "Field" betting in Doubles "Field" betting an investor selects one horse in any one leg of a Double with ALL the runners in the other leg. For example, a horse, say No. 7, in thefirst leg, could be coupled with all, the horses ("the Field") in the 2nd leg, in which case the investor would ask for "No. 7 and the Field", or the investor may desire to have all runners ("the Field") in the 1st leg coupled with a horse, say No. 5, in the 2nd ler, in which case he would ask for "the Field and No. 5". The same principle applies to Quinella "Field" betting. Of course the investor's outlay is greater, being governed by the number of horses in "the Field". A Doubles or Quinella ticket in "Field" betting can be issued just as quickly as a Single ticket for a combination of only two horses.

- 5. In Totalisator Doubles:---
 - (a) You are entitled to a REFUND of your stake -
 - (1) If your horse in the 1st leg is withdrawn, regardless of whether your horse in the 2nd leg wins or does not start:
 - (2) If your horse in the 2nd leg is withdrawn PRIOR to the running of the 1st leg, regardless of whether your horse in the 1st leg wins or loses.
 - (b) NO REFUND is made if your horse in the 1st leg loses and your horse in the 2nd leg is scratched after the running of the 1st ieg.

(c) If your horse in the 1st leg wins and your horse in the 2nd leg is withdrawn AFTER the running of the 1st leg your het is deemed to be transferred to such other horse as the Trotting Control Board shall determine and announce prior to the running of the 2nd leg. In making its determination, the Board is required, as far as practicable to substitute for the withdrawn horse the starter which carries the greatest amount of money in combination with the winner of the 1st leg.

The foregoing shall also apply if your horse in the 2nd leg is withdrawn from a re-run of a race in which it had taken part.

. QUINELLA (RACE PAIRS) BETTING -

This a form of Doubles betting on any one race. A Quincila will operate on every race.

The investor may select any two horses in the race, for example Nos. 3 and 11, and if those horses fill the first two placings IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER THEY ARE PLACED FIRST AND SECOND OR SECOND AND FIRST, the investors on Nos. 3 and 11 are entitled to collect the dividend declared on the Quinella. As in doubles betting the investor may take the whole field if he wishes (see paragraph 5).

On the last race all Doubles Windows will be open for Ouinella betting.

WARNING RE DOUBLES and QUINELLA

It is possible that there may not be any investors on a winning combination in which event the Doubles and Quinella pools would be divided among the investors as follows:--

If your selection is placed in the first leg of a double or in the Quinella DO NOT DISCARD OR DESTROY YOUR TICKET until the winning combination and dividend are posted.

STEWARDS' REPORT

SATURDAY, 14th FEBRUARY, 1970

AUCKLAND STAKES: H. V. Bromfield "Cassius Bay" was questioned as to why he left his run so late. He stated that it was his intention to go turning into the home straight in the second last lap, but horses ahead of him went and he expected to get a good trail. This did not eventuate, and he was forced wide in the back straight. The horse was racing in a strange sulky, and on the turns was striking the wheel. His explanation was noted.

CHRISTCHURCH HANDICAP: "Festival Lad" (V. Frost) began slowly. and broke without interference turning out of the home straight in the last lap. A warning was issued.

"Memory Hill" (W. Clarke) veered sideways at the start, severely checking "Son of Nancy" (G. D. Wilson) and "Daring Sally" (C. Phillis), and to a lesser extent, "Last Flood" (B. Gath). A warning was issued.

1970 INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP (First Qualifying Division): "Waitaki Elect" (G. D. Wilson) and "Future Intangible" (W. Davies) began badly. In future Divisions both horses will be excluded from the barrier draw.

"Imatoff" (K. Innes) broke without reason twice in the first lap, and again turning into the home straight in the last lap. Innes was warned that he must correct the horse of this fault.

"Adios Court" (C. Webster) began slowly, and mixed its gait for a few strides after the start.

"Garcon Roux" (J. Noble) broke when checked off the breaking "Future Intangible" (W. Davies) approaching the first turn after the start, and again without interference in the bell lap. Warnings were issued in each case.

"Royal Society" (P. Hall) lugged out badly in each straight. Hall was advised to make more effort to keep this horse straight in future.

1970 INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP (Second Qualifying Division): "Bar Adios" (R. Ford) and "Blue Pennant" (F. Hough) began badly. In future Divisions, "Bar Adios" will be excluded from the barrier draw, and permission has been granted for "Blue Pennant" to be held at the start.

C. Phillis "Hi Efficiency" was severely reprimanded for excessive use of the whip in the latter stages of the race.

1970 INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP (Third Qualifying Division): "Joseph Scott" (H. V. Bromfield) and "Lucky Creed" (V. Frost) both began badly. In future Divisions they will be excluded from the barrier draw.

STEWARDS' REPORT -- Continued.

WELCOME TROTTERS' FREE-FOR-ALL: "Adios Van" (K. Webster) broke without interference at the start. In future, it will be excluded from the draw in mobile barrier races. A warning was issued to "Satan's Shadow" (N. McSween), which broke without interference soon after the start, and to "Delvin Glenfern" (G. Gath), which broke without interference in the last lap. A swab was taken from the winner, "Precccious" (R. Mitchell). R. Mitchell "Precocious" was severely reprimended for tightening "My Lesson" (A. Simons) at the turn into the back straight in the second lap. As a result of this tightening "My Lesson" (A. Simons) broke, and "Delvin Glenfern" (G. Gath) was crecked and mixed its gait. 1970 INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIP (Fourth Qualifying Division): "Koala Frost" (K. Newman), "Roscott" (L. Lindau), "The Rogue" (F. R. Kersley) and "Future Monarch" (W. Davies) began badly. In the remaining Division these horses will be excluded from the draw.

STEWARDS' REPORT Meeting, 18th February, 1970

TROTTING DRIVERS' ACCIDENT COMPENSATION SCHEME AND M. & C.T.A. SULKY FUND

All drivers participating in races here tonight are covered by the Board's Accident Scheme and owners' Sulkies are covered under the conditions of the Sulky Fund.

MOBILE BARRIER

A false start will NOT be declared because any horse is galloping. It is the drivers' responsibility to have their horses in their gear and in the proper positions. A false start may be signalled only if a horse scores ahead

of the barrier or there is interference, broken gear or a fall. A green light on the barrier signifies a start.


