SCRATCHING TIMES

Under Rule 234 (1) (a) and (c) Horses not intending to start MUST BE SCRATCHED BY 7.30 a.m. on the day of the Day Meeting and by 2.00 P.M. on the day of the Night Meetings.

LATE SCRATCHINGS

Rule 234 (9): "In any race which includes horses balloted out, and/or eliminated with right of re-entry as provided under Rule 177/1 (F), should a horse already in the field be scratched following the re-entry scratching times laid down under that rule, it shall be necessary for the Owner or his authorised agent to produce to the Stipendiary Stewards a Veterinary Certificate or otherwise sufficient reason for such late scratching. Failure to comply or to satisfy the Stipendiary Stewards that the scratching was warranted shall incur a fine not exceeding \$50."

The re-entry scratching time at this meeting is 12.00 noon on the day prior to race day.

UNRULY HORSES

If the letters U.R. appear in place of the Barrier Draw it means that, that particular horse has been declared unruly by the Stipendiary Steward and such horse shall start from a second line on the extreme outside from behind and clear of the front line horses. If there are other horses on the second line the horse or horses so declared unruly shall start on the extreme outside of the second line and clear of the front and second line horses.

DOUBLES / QUINELLA / FORECAST

True Double refers to the purchase at the same time of one ticket to record an investment on two horses - each horse running in a separate

An investment on two runners in one race to finish in ANY order is known as "Quinella" betting, or if in the CORRECT order "Forecast" betting, and both are "Combination betting.

DOUBLES RACES

Dividends will be declared on a concession basis of 1st Horse 2nd Leg 70% 2nd Horse 2nd Leg 30%

unless otherwise directed.

DOUBLES PRE-SELECTION TOTALISATOR

Doubles totalisator will operate on two consecutive races, viz., the first and second race, the second and third race and so on. The Double investors must ask for the number of the Horse they select as the first leg and the number of the Horse in the second leg, thus, "No. 1 and No. 4". It is important to mention first the number of the Horse in the first race, and second, the number of the Horse in the second leg.

When it is desired to purchase a ticket on one Horse in one race of the double and on all Horses in the other race of the double, the word "Field" is used to include all the Horses, and on the ticket appears as the letter "F". To obtain a ticket to include one Horse in the first race and all Horses in the second race of the double, ask for "No. 1 in the first race, the field in the second race" or if it is desired to couple all the Horses in the first race of the double with one Horse in the second race, ask for "the field in the first race, No. 1 in the second race." Double investors are reminded to hold their tickets until the dividend is declared.

LATE SCRATCHING

If before the Double Totalisator closes a late scratching occurs in either leg of the Double, and the horse scratched is not bracketed with another horse which is a starter the bet is off and the investor may change his ticket or claim a refund. If, after the First Leg of the Double and the horse scratched is not bracketed with another horse which is a starter the investment on the scratched horse shall be transferred to the On-Course favourite on the Doubles Totalisator.

QUINELLA TOTALISATOR

This Totalisator is for investors to invest in any selected race for the purpose of nominating the two Horses which shall be placed first and second in one and the same race irrespective of which Horse is placed fiirst or which Horse is placed second in the race on which the Quinella

Investors must ask for the numbers of the two Horses they select to fill first and second places, asking for the lowest number first.

FORECAST TOTALISATOR

This Totalisator is for investors to invest in a selected race(s) for Forecast betting for the purpose of nominating the two Horses which must be placed first and second.

Investors must ask for the numbers of the two Horses selected to fill first and second places with their first selected number first.

TRUE DOUBLES DIVISION RACES

- 1. Select your combination(s) before approaching a selling Window.
- Units will be \$1.00.
- 3. Brackets are NOT recognised unless in the same Division.
- 4. For the purpose of these Doubles all numbers are treated as whole numbers.
- 5. If the horse you selected carries the letter "A" or "B" next to the number ask only for the whole number. (e.g. 22A ask for 22). If you select the same number in each division ask for (e.g. 10 & 10).
- 7. You must ask for the first division number first, followed by the
- second division number. 8. REMEMBER. For the purpose of these doubles, only both divisions are treated as separate races. Brackets are NOT recognised.
 - If the horse you select wins the first division and the horse you select wins or runs second in the second division you receive a dividend.

ELECTRIC INDICATORS - WIN AND PLACE

Automatically calculated dividends for Win and Place betting will be shown on the Electric Indicators. Dividends are shown in two lines, with the Win Dividend appearing on the top line, and the Place Dividend on the bottom line.

Automatic Win and Place Lampboxes have been designed by the manufacturer to display dividends between \$1 and \$99 but the mechanism can show only one of 35 different dividends for any horse.

For dividends between \$1 and \$4.50 a red strip will separate the dollars from the cents and numbers to the right of this red decimal strip will represent units of 10 cents, e.g. 4.5 = \$4.50.


COLLECTION OF TOTALISATOR TICKETS

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

First Night, Saturday, 1st February, 1975

Race 1. John W. Andrew & Sons Ltd. Mobile Stakes: Too Cute broke free of interference after approximately 300 metres.

Race 2. Karamea Centennial Mobile Stakes: Classic Move broke prior to the gate being released and lost considerable ground.

Race 4. Sonny Elegant Knitwear Handicap: Montana Gold, Max Brydon and Disciple were slow away.

Race 5. First Pacers' Qualifying Heat: A false start was declared when the driver of Just Too Good complained to the starter that he thought his sulky had been damaged during the run-up. It was found that the nut had worked loose on the sulky wheel, this was tightened and the re-run was satisfactory. Shortly after the start Ian Henry was tightened up and broke when the outside horses, namely Yallara and Master Dean and Young Quinn, when vying for positions approaching the bend out of the straight. The drivers of the outside horses were reminded of their obligations and cautioned to exercise more care. Royal Gaze and Micron were slow to start.

Race 6. First Trotters' Qualifying Heat: Balia's Best and Rannach Ray were slow away. Butch Cassidy and Flagon Wagon broke losing all chance. Dupreez broke on two occasions free of interference. B. Running, driver of the favoutite Easton Light was questioned regarding the performance of this horse. Running stated that it had been working well before the meeting and was disappointed with its effort. He stated that he thought the horse had hung badly and failed to show dash. It is thought that there is a possibility that the horse's teeth may be the cause of him hanging and these will be looked at before the horse races on the second night.

Race 7. Second Pacers' Qualifying Heat: Turning into the straight for the first time Alluvial Gold broke free of interference and with 800 metres to run Hondo Gratton which was three back on the fence attempted to ease out behind Kotare Legend in doing so struck that horse's wheel and broke. Kotare Legend pulled a damaged wheel the remainder of the journey. Turnbull was reminded of his obligations in attempting to improve his position.


Race 8. Second Trotters' Qualifying Heat: Jillinda and Bay Johnny both broke at the start. Jillinda losing all chance. With approximately 500 metres to run Bay Johnny which was making a big run broke free of interference and Waipounamu broke free of interference, and doing so caused a check to Do Enquire who also broke.

Race 9. Third Pacers' Qualifying Heat: Bold Jason was noticed hanging on the turns. Go Van finished on strongly after clearing tiring horses.






PHOTO CAMERA FINISHES, SECOND NIGHT

BENSON & HEDGES INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIPS STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Second Night, Wednesday, 5th February, 1975

- Race 2. Jetspress Mobile Stakes: White Devon broke and lost ground prior to the start. P. Jessop, the driver of Dawn Mate, ...as aned \$5.00 for the manner in which he used his whip.
- Race 3. Lion Breweries Mobile Stakes: Playdate broke at the start of this event. After approximately 200 metres, Shavern, driven by R. Starr, checked Good Intent (A. K. Holmes) causing this noise to break. Blue Beat, which was following closely behind received a resultant check, broke, failed to settle down and was finally putted up. R. Starr was called before the Judicial Committee and, after hearing evidence, from the abovementioned drivers and viewary are fitm, Starr was fined \$40.00 for careless driving.
- Race 4. Third Trotters' Qualifying Heat: Lessaday, Darky Forbes and Bay Johnny all made mistakes during this event free o. In orderence.
- Race 5. Fourth Pacers' Qualifying Heat: Speedy Ben w.s very slow away. Irish Kiwi paced roughly in the early stage. and proke again later, free of interference. With a round to go Pale. and proke moved out from behind Marie Gibbins and in doing so punctated Marie Gibbins tyre. J. A. Carmichael, driver of Micron, w. stated \$25.00 for failing to maintain his position behind the mobile barrier.
- Race 6. Civic Tavern Handicap: This race was marred by an accident that eliminated a number of competitors, these included Good Sport, Mexican Chief, Marshall Hanover, Jack Robin on John Robert, Caledonian Garrison, Happy Fella, Hal Foyle and Disciple and Montana Gold was checked. Following this event. L. Knight, driver of Lordy Boy, was charged with causing interference. After viewing the film L. Knight was found guilty of care associativing and his licence was suspended up to and including March 18th.
- Race 7. Fifth Pacers' Qualifying Heat: Bold Jason and Final Decision both broke at the start of this event and with approximately 400 metres to run Kotare Legend which was pulling hard at the time, had nowhere to go and ran out of his gear, in doing so checked and came back on to Captain Harcourt causing that horse to break. At the conclusion of this event an adjourned enquiry into an inciden as the field returned to home between Vanadium and Bold Jason will be heard on the third night.
- Race 8. Fourth Trotters' Qualifying Heat: Carmen Suva, Flagon Wagon and Cee Ar all made mistakes at the start or during the running, Carmen Suva losing all chance.
- Race 9. Sixth Pacers' Qualifying Heat: An enquiry was opened and ajourned into the falling of Ian Henry and the breaking of Alluvial Gold which occurred approximately 250 metres after the start.



CONDITIONS GOVERNING INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIPS

(1) MAXIMUM HANDICAP MARKS:

For both Pacing and Trotting events the maximum handicap marks will be as under:—

3,200	Metres	 	 	30	Metres	behind

2) RE-HANDICAPS:

The Handicapper shall not alter the handicap mark of any horse after the declaration of handicaps unless a horse appearing in the handicaps shall win an event exceeding \$N.Z.20,000 to the winner and then it will be within the power of the Handicapper to use discretion as to whether or not a penalty may be imposed, provided that any proposal to rehandicap shall be first referred to the Committee of the Controlling Body.

(3) FIXED HANDICAPS:

Once a Horse is handicapped for the Championships no penalty will be incurred in the Grand Finals as a result of any placed performance in a Qualifying Race.

(4) QUALIFYING RACES (or heats of same):

The aim of the Championships Programme Committee is that there will not be more than three heats (in the case of the Trotter's Championship, two heats) in any Qualifying Race and not more than 12 Horses in any one heat. The Committee reserves the right to vary these figures. Qualifying heats. First to Sixth inclusive for Pacers and Third and Fourth for Trotters will be run under Free-For-All Conditions.

The Pacers Free-For-Alls will be started from behind the Mobile Barrier.

Heats of Qualifying Races will be run as separate races and the Totalisator will open on each Heat separately.

Fields for the Qualifying Divisions will be selected from the final acceptors and preference may be given to Horses which have won at least 4 penalty bearing races at any Metropolitan track in Australia and New Zealand. However selection will be based on current form.

(5) POINTS SYSTEM:

Qualifying points for the Championships Grand Finals shall be awarded to each Horse actually starting and finishing a race of the Qualifying Divisions on the basis that the winner of a Race of a Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the previously selected by the Auckland Trotting Club (Inc.) as the maximum number of Horses to compete in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second Horse in each Race of the Qualifying Division will receive in points the equivalent of the number of Horses third Horses will receive the next lower number with each Horse actually finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding Horse until the last Horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.

The winner of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive one (1) bonus point to be added to the points already earned by the winner of that race.

There will be no points awarded for fastest time.

A Horse that is scratched from a Race of the Qualifying Divisions or a Horse that does not complete a Race will not be awarded any points for that Race.

In the event of a scratching or a Horse not completeing the Course, points will be awarded as before with the winner and other Horses finishing the Race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had completed and finished the Course in

that particular race. In the event of a dead heat all points of the Horses dead heating shall be added together and equally divided among the Horses dead

heating.

(6) The twelve (12) Horses which gain the greatest aggregate of points shall be eligible to start in the Grand Finals, but should circumstances warrant such a course of action the Grand Council of the Inter-Dominion Conference shall have the power to increase the numbers of starters above the designated number and to select the additional

In the event of two or more Horses each scoring equally the minimum number of points entitling them to be eligible for the Grand Finals and thereby producing a field exceeding the number designated by the Auckland Trotting Club (Inc.) or producing a field exceeding the safety number permitted for Alexandra Park Raceway, then the Grand Council shall decide in its discretion which of the Horses with equal points shall start in the Grand Finals.

The Championships Programme Committee shall be the sole judge of which Horses are entitled to start in the Consolation Races.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING INTER-DOMINION CHAMPIONSHIPS

- (1) All Races will be run and all proceedings in connection therewith conducted under the New Zealand Rules of Trotting and subject to these conditions and to the Regulations laid down by the Inter-Dominion Trotting Conference.
- (2) Subject to the previous consent of the President of the New Zealand Trotting Conference the Committee of the Auckland Trotting Club (Inc.) will have the right to:-
 - (a) Alter the order in which races on any Programme are advertised to be run.
 - (b) Alter the limit, the stake, or any of the conditions of any of the Races.
 - (c) Cancel the Championships events in which case all money received will be refunded.
 - (d) Increase or decrease the number of Heats in the Qualifying Races or decrease the number of Consolation Races and amend the number of other events on the Programme.
- (3) The Committee of the Auckland Trotting Club (Inc.) reserves the right to reject the nomination of any Horse in which case the decision of the Committee will be final and binding on all parties.
- (4) The Committee of the Auckland Trotting Club (Inc.) reserves the right to select the Horses to start in the Inter-Dominion Championships.

(5) HANDICAPPING PENALTIES:

- (a) All Qualifying Races (or Heats) and Consolation Races are penalty free in Australia and New Zealand.
- (b) The Winners of the Grand Finals shall be penalised in accordance with the handicapping regulations of the respective Countries.

(6) HORSES ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE GRAND FINAL:

To be eligible to compete in the Grand Final Horses shall start in each Qualifying Race unless exemption is made by the Grand Council who shall decide upon each case according to its merit.



AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB (inc.)

Extract from N.Z. Gazette, 22 November 1973, No. 107, p. 2438

New Zealand Trotting Conference.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971 the New Zealand Trotting Conference resolves to and does hereby make the following rules controlling the admission of persons to all racecourses used by racing clubs which are now or may at any time hereafter be registered with the said New Zealand Trotting Conference.

RULES

(Under the Racing Act 1971)

- These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the New Zealand Gazette.
- 2. In these rules, the words "racecourse", "racing club" and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by section 2 of the Racing Act 1971 and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908 or any subsequent consolidating or in substitution of such Act.
- 3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all race-courses used by racing clubs which are now or may at any time hereafter be registered with the New Zealand Trotting Conference with such racecourses, or any thereof, are being used by any club for a race meeting namely:
- (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under the New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand which have reciprocal agreements in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference;
- (b) Bookmakers:
- (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawfully taking or conversion of motorcar or other vehicles, false pretences, forgery, uttering possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
- (d) Persons convicted of any offence under the Gaming Act 1908 or of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961; murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), crimes involving dishonestry or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or insubstitution thereof;
- (c) Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d).

Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing and Trotting Conferences upon being satisfied as to the character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof, may grant exemption to any such person.

4. All regulations previously made under section 33 of the Gaming Act 1908 by any such Racing Club registered as aforesaid shall be deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the day on which these rules are published in the said Gazette and shall thereafter have no effect.

The foregoing rules are hereby approved.
